Vacaville Unified High School District, Vacaville, CA

Wallace was the Principle-In-Charge of \$158 million modernization and new construction program (Measure V) which included over 50 projects, completed in 2012. Duties included facilitation and overview of the integrated project delivery (IPD) process, oversight of the program management team that provides assessments, project scoping, design review, budget development, design-phase oversight, project construction coordination and project closeout for all projects. Developed and managed all contracts necessary to Program. Currently Wallace oversees the construction managers involved with project delivery for the current VUSD Measure A Program.

Vacaville Unified School District Headquarters – ESC Building (2009 – 2011), Vacaville, CA

Wallace was the Project Manager for the District's new headquarters facility, Educational Services Center. Prior to the acquisition of the building, Wallace worked with a team of architects and engineers to provide a thorough investigation of the structure and systems. The team discovered \$250,000 of corrections that were required prior to the close of escrow. The \$3M project was delivered with the use of design-build MEP under lease-leaseback agreement. Duties included project oversight, contract development and negotiations, design review, construction oversight, project closeout and owner move-in. Project was completed ahead of schedule and with a \$210,000 savings to the District.

Mariposa County Unified School District, Mariposa CA

Wallace is the Principle-In-Charge of a \$24 million modernization and new construction program (Measure L). Duties include facilitation, overview and oversight of the program and construction management team that provides project scoping, design review, budget development, design-phase oversight, and project and construction management coordination through project closeout for all projects.
